On 29 September 2017, Chance4all was born....

Since then, we have been able to enroll and send back to school 25 children across all ages, guaranteeing them the finalization of the Education Cycle that they are enrolled in. In addition to receiving financial support the children benefit from targeted tuition assistance, mentoring and nutrition support on a weekly basis.

Twenty-five children may seem a drop in the ocean... but as the proverb says, **“drop after drop you break the rock”**. We have, indeed, observed a profound transformation in the children benefiting from the Chance4all scholarship programme, a change often

extended to their families. We believe they will have the capacity to break out of the cycle of poverty, becoming agents of positive change in the community.

We firmly believe that the Right to Education is a fundamental human right, and that no child, anywhere in the world, should ever be deprived of education. We commit ourselves fully to make this Right happen. One child at the time.
